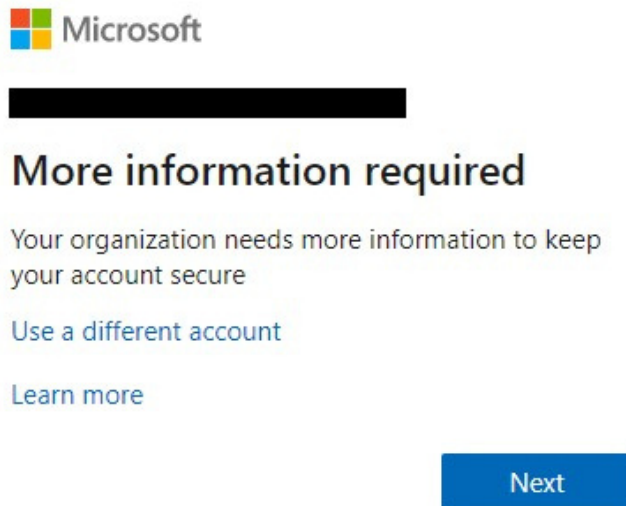

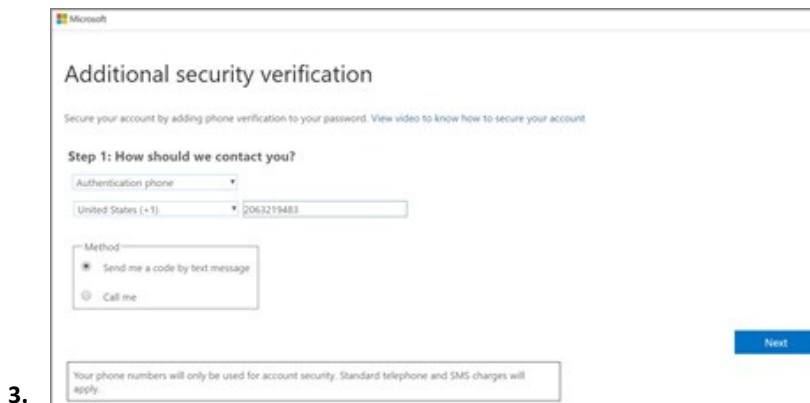

User enrollment into MFA:

1. Sign into Office 365 (www.office.com) with your work account and password like normal. After you choose **Sign in**, you'll see this page:



2. Choose **Next**. MFA can be setup using a text message, phone call, or authenticator app. We recommend setting up MFA with the authenticator app with "receive notification for verification" for the most secure and easiest end user experience.



- 4 After you verify your alternate contact method, choose **Next**.
- **At the end of the enrollment you will be provided an App password. This App password will be needed if you access email via the built in **Apple Mail app or Android Gmail mail app**. Choose the copy icon to copy the password to your clipboard and stored in a safe location. You won't need to memorize this password.**

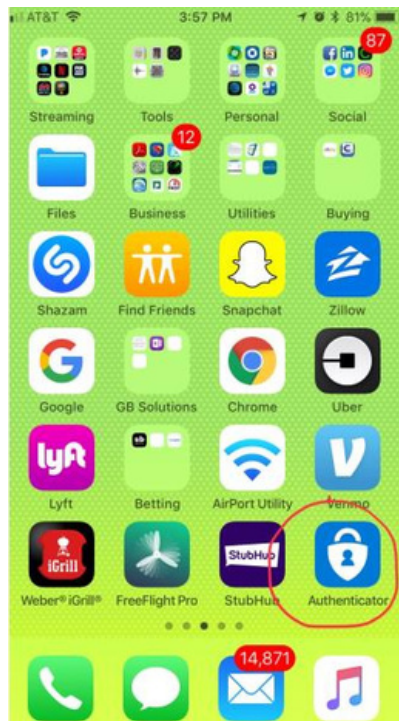

- Once you click Set up, you will need to download the Microsoft Authenticator app to proceed.

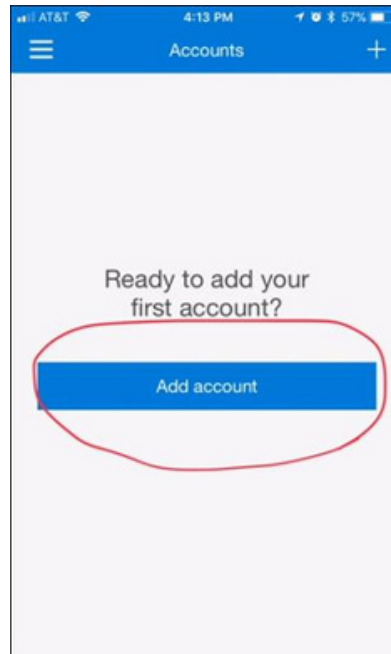


- Once it is downloaded, Open the App

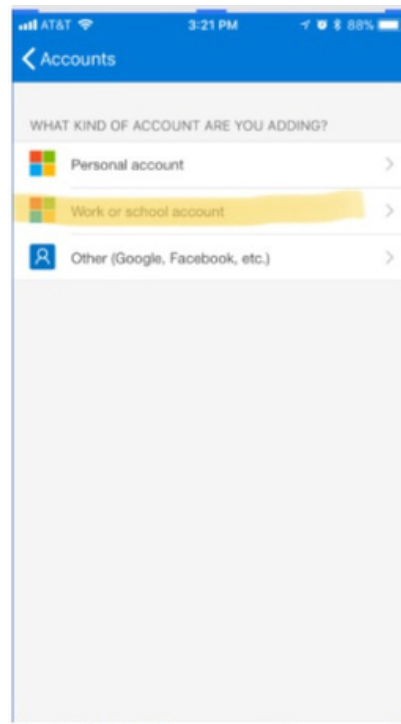




5. Once open, select the Add account button

Configure app without notifications

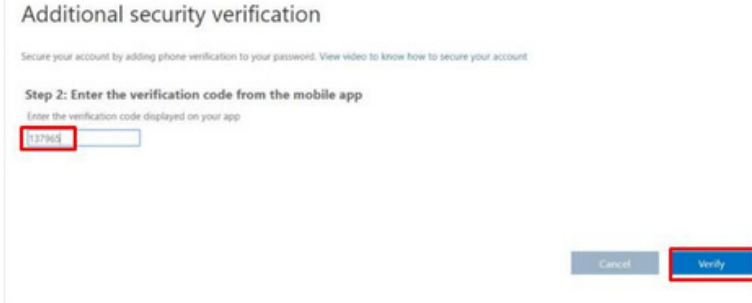
